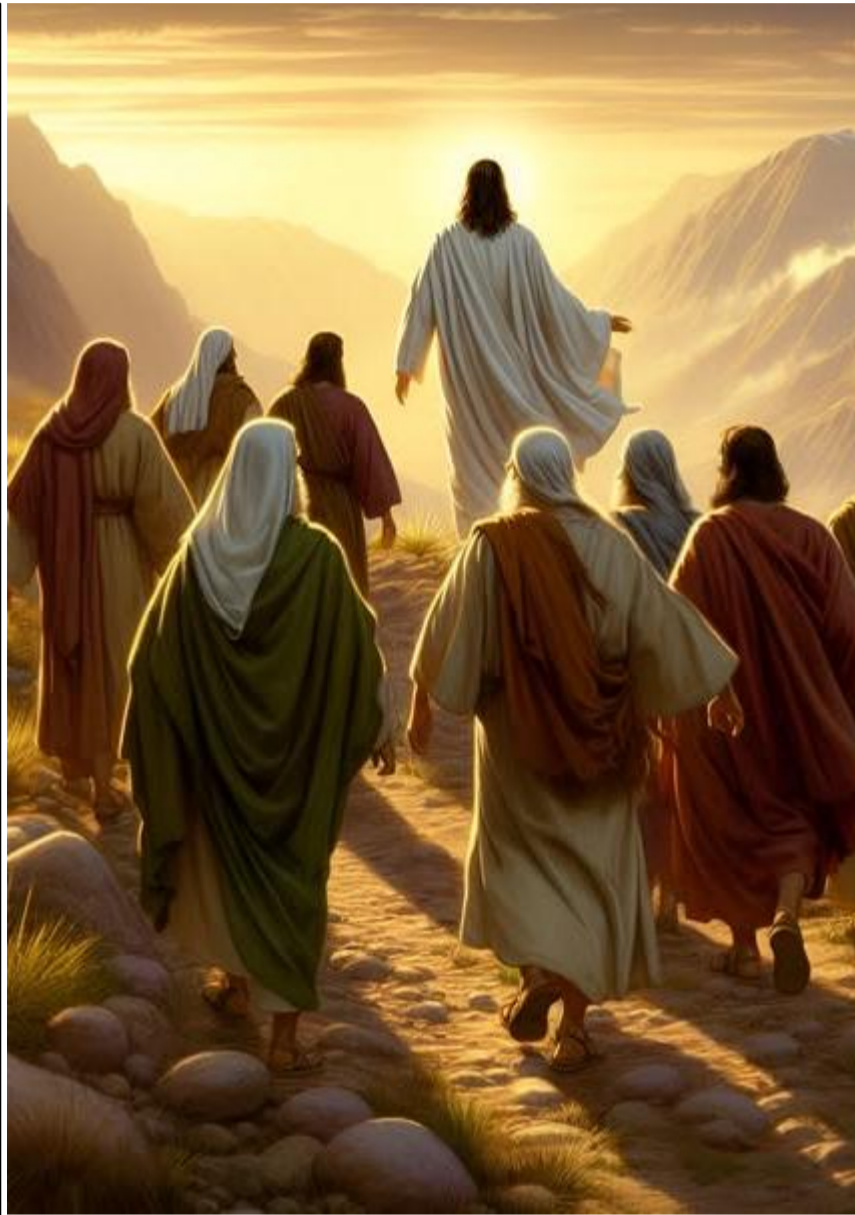
11th Sunday in Ordinary Time 2026 Year A, 13 | 14 June 2026

1st Reading: Exodus 19: 2-6
Psalms 99: we are His people: the sheep of his flock.
2nd Reading: Romans 5: 6-11
Gospel: Matthew 9: 36-10:8

At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with pity for them because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is abundant but the labourers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out labourers for his harvest."

Then he summoned his twelve disciples and gave them authority over unclean spirits to drive them out and to cure every disease and every illness. The names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon called Peter, and his brother Andrew; James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James, the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddeus; Simon from Cana, and Judas Iscariot who betrayed him.

Jesus sent out these twelve after instructing them thus, "Do not go into pagan territory or enter a Samaritan town. Go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. As you go, make this proclamation: 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand.' Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons. Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give."



THE HARVEST IS RICH.

Aware of the vast numbers of people who were harassed and dejected Jesus called twelve apostles to share in his mission. They were to do the same works as Jesus, healing the sick and proclaiming the kingdom of heaven. Christ still needs helpers to share in his mission: At the end of each Mass Christ sends us out to love and serve God and one another.

Our Cultural Mass at the 9:00 a.m. Mass will celebrate the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This year, our Samoan Community will lead the celebration as we come together in faith and unity to consecrate our community to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Let us continue to keep our children in prayer as they prepare for their First Holy Communion on 21 June 2026 at the 9:00 a.m. Mass. May the Risen Lord nourish and strengthen them with the Bread of Life as they grow as faithful followers of Christ.

We warmly encourage every community to bring something to share (food or drinks) as we come together to welcome and celebrate our children, who will be fully united in Holy Communion within our Catholic faith.

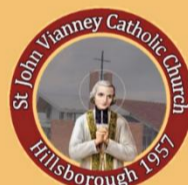
ST JOHN VIANNEY SAFEGUARDING STATEMENT



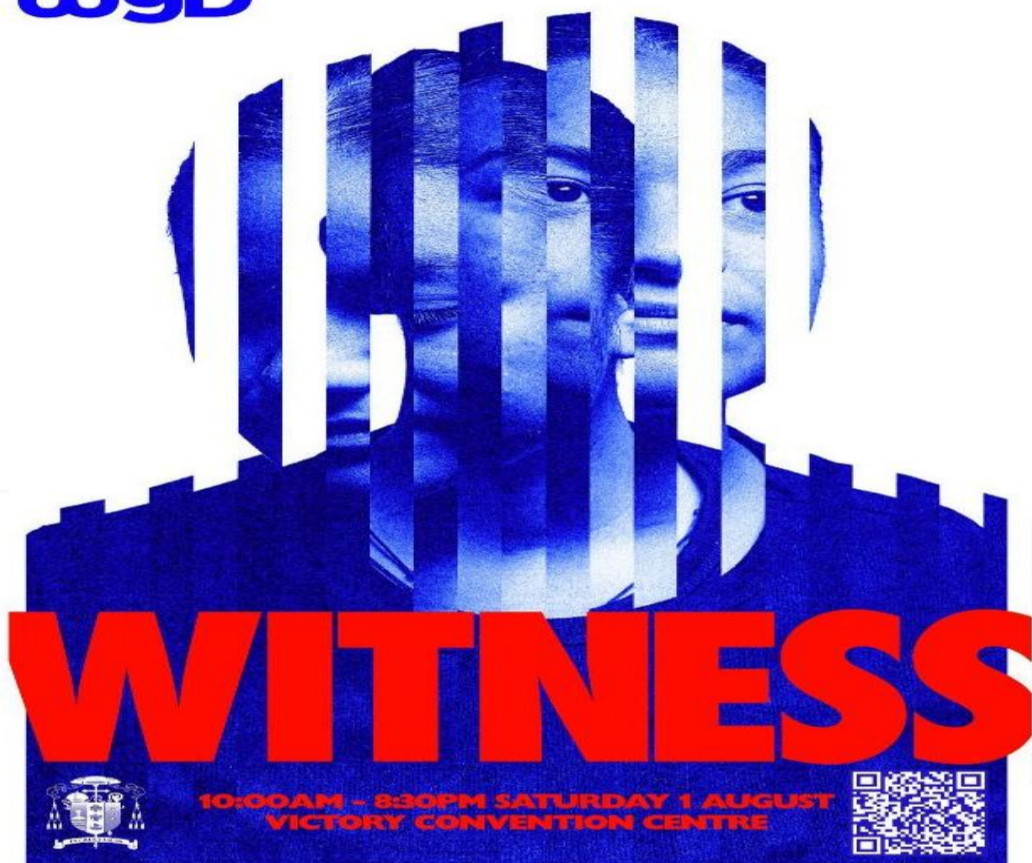
