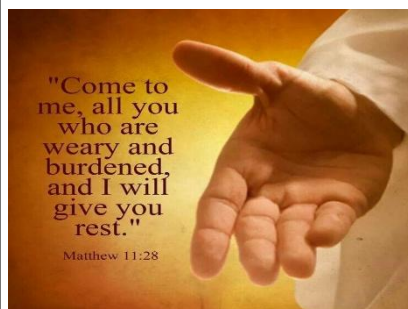
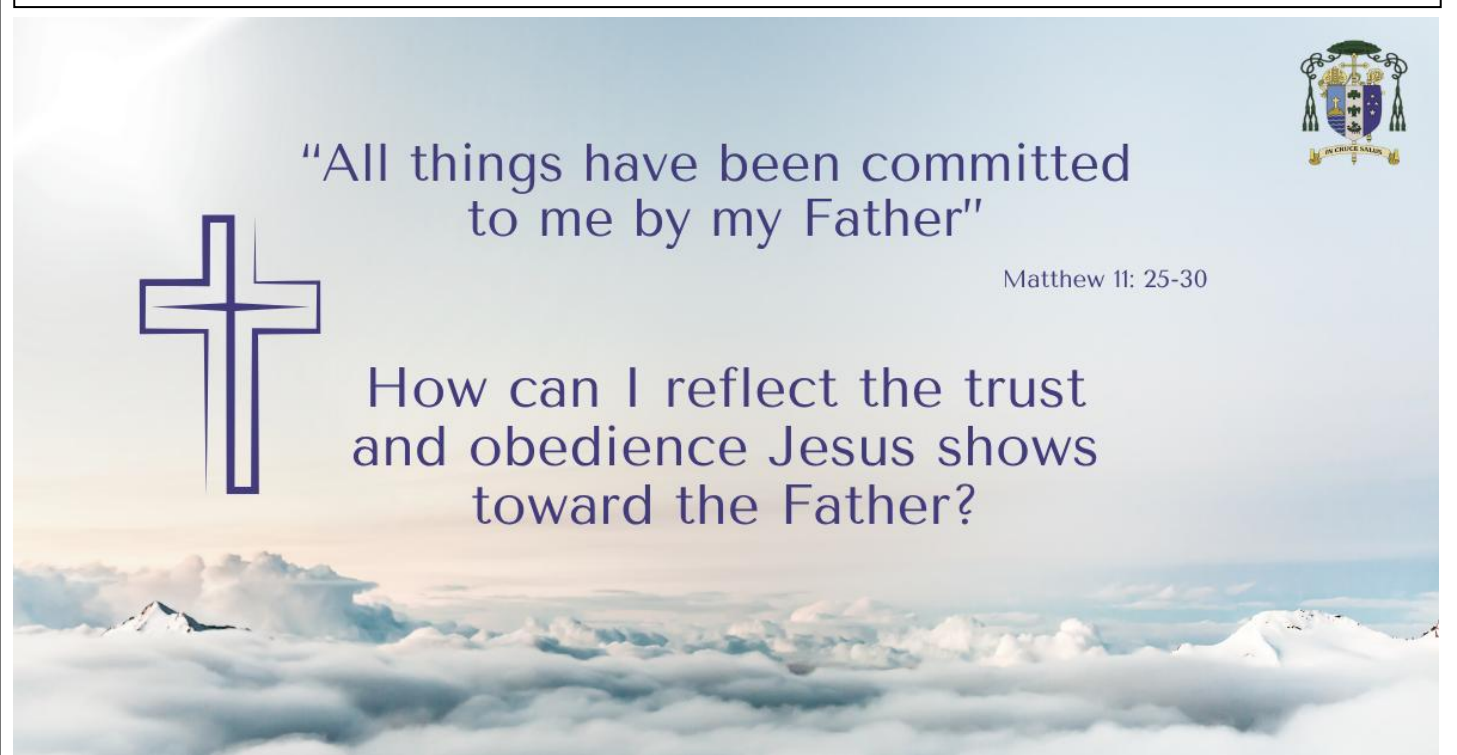
2nd Reading: Romans 6:3-4,8-11

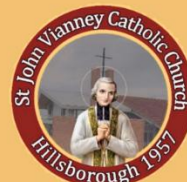
ST JOHN VIANNEY SAFEGUARDING STATEMENT

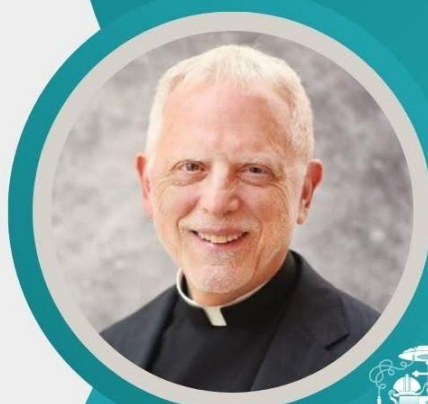
