
A priest happened to be going down that road, but when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side.


Likewise, a Levite came to the place, and when he saw him, he passed by on the opposite side.

Which of these three, in your opinion, was neighbour to the robbers' victim?" He answered, "The one who treated him with mercy." Jesus said to him, "Go and do likewise."







How am I actively showing compassion and mercy to others in my daily life—especially to those who are different from me or whom I find difficult to love?

TO WHOM CAN I BE A NEIGHBOUR?

The command to love our neighbour is as broad as our definition of the word neighbour. Are the people living next door the only ones we consider to be our neighbours? Do we include people in neighbouring streets, towns, or countries, and people of other faiths? Jesus answers these questions by telling the story of the Good Samaritan. As we hear this story, we realise that the key question is never, "who is my neighbour?', rather, 'to whom can I be a neighbour?
